Status- PARTIAL ACTIVATION

INCIDENTS AND EVENTS:

- Danville An unknown quantity of #2 fuel oil spilled due to a 2,000 gallon tanker truck rollover. The Agency of Natural Resources and the VT Hazardous Materials Response Team (VTHMRT) were notified.
- Chester Approximately 200-300 gallons of diesel fuel spilled due to a tractor trailer and car accident. The Agency of Natural Resources and the VT Hazardous Materials Response Team (VTHMRT) were notified.
- Newport An epoxy generated noxious fumes at the Northern State Correctional Facility resulting in two
 persons being transported to the hospital. The Agency of Natural Resources and the VT Hazardous Materials
 Response Team (VTHMRT) were notified.

RESOURCES DEPLOYED:

- The Vermont Hazardous Material Response Team (VTHMRT) responded to the Danville incident with a strike team, Truck #4, and a HazMat Trailer.
- The Vermont Hazardous Material Response Team (VTHMRT) responded to the Newport incident with a strike team.
