# **Status- PARTIAL ACTIVATION**

# **INCIDENTS AND EVENTS:**

- The State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) was at Partial Activation status from 0800 to 1630 on 8/1/2024 and then returned to Monitoring status for the overnight period, for the severe weather event.
- St. Johnsbury –20 gallons of heating oil spilled, Agency of Natural Resources notified.
- St. Johnsbury Watch Officer provided VT-Alert subscriber only assistance.
- Barnet 35 gallons of diesel fuel spilled. HazMat and Agency of Natural Resources notified.
- Lyndonville Assessment of inaccessible areas, community needs, and hazardous material spills due to flooding damage.
- Vermont Fire Danger Forecast
