Status- PARTIAL ACTIVATION

INCIDENTS AND EVENTS:

- The State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) was at Partial Activation status from 0800 to 1630 on 8/7/2024 and then returned to Monitoring status for the overnight period, for the severe weather event.
- Danby - A building collapsed trapping several animals inside. The Vermont Urban Search and Rescue team (USAR) and Vermont Hazardous Material Response Team (VTHMRT) were notified.
- Sheldon - A vehicle was submerged in the Missisquoi River. The Vermont Hazardous Materials Response Team (VTHMRT) and Agency of Natural Resources were notified.
- Graniteville - Approximately 50 gallons of hydraulic oil spilled. The Vermont Hazardous Materials Response Team (VTHMRT) and Agency of Natural Resources were notified.

RESOURCES DEPLOYED:

- The Vermont Urban Search and Rescue Team (USAR) responded to the Danby incident with ten personnel to provide structural shoring of a collapsed building and rescue of several animals.
