Status- PARTIAL ACTIVATION

INCIDENTS AND EVENTS:

- The State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) was at Partial Activation status from 0800 to 1630 on 8/11/2024 and then returned to Monitoring status for the overnight period, for the severe weather event.
- Newport Report of a submerged boat in Lake Memphremagog. The Agency of Natural Resources and the VT Hazardous Materials Response Team were notified.
