Status- MONITORING

INCIDENTS AND EVENTS:

- Bradford Report of an unknown quantity of water containing chemicals dumped at a private residence. The Agency of Natural Resources and the VT Hazardous Materials Response Team were notified.
- Vermont Fire Danger Forecast

RESOURCES DEPLOYED:

- Task Force 1 (TF1) swiftwater team deployed fourteen personnel to support the State of Florida in response to Tropical Storm Helene, with multiple swiftwater/flood rescue resources for a 14-day deployment through 10/8/2024.
- VT Hazardous Materials Response Team (VTHMRT) deployed a crew of six personnel and the LP trailer for a leaking underground LP tank in support of the Ludlow Fire Department.
- Forest Parks and Recreation wildland fire team deployed three personnel in response to a 0.1-acre smoldering fire in the Groton State Forest.
