RESOURCES DEPLOYED:

• Task Force 1 (TF1) swiftwater team deployed seven additional personnel (currently totaling 21), with vehicles and equipment, as they pivoted from supporting the State of Florida, to augment their swiftwater/flood rescue resources and assist the State of North Carolina in Ashville. Their 14-day deployment in response to Hurricane Helene will continue through 10/8/2024.
