- Barton - Fuel oil spill of an unknown quantity. Vermont Agency of Natural Resources notified.
- Huntington - Out of control brush fire operation supported by Vermont Forests, Parks and Recreation.
- Williston - Out of control brush fire operation supported by Vermont Forests, Parks and Recreation.
- White River Junction - Hazardous materials incident. Vermont Hazardous Materials Response Team, Vermont Department of Health and Vermont National Guard Joint Operations Center notified.

- White River Junction - The Vermont Hazardous Materials Response Team deployed Truck 3, Car 1 and six personnel to support operations at a potential hazardous materials incident.
