- Grand Isle Two gallons of motor oil spilled on a state roadway. The Agency of Natural Resources was notified.

RESOURCES DEPLOYED:

• Barnard - Four members of the VT Hazardous Material Response Team (VTHMRT) deployed to support Vermont Forest Parks and Recreation (FPR) wildland fire personnel and the Barnard Fire Department, providing Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) support for an ongoing wildland fire. University of Vermont Spatial Analysis Lab personnel and Green Mountain National Forest (GMNF) firefighters were also deployed to the incident.
