Status- MONITORING

INCIDENTS AND EVENTS:

- East Montpelier Report of an ammonia alarm, later suspected to be a sensor issue. The VT Hazardous Material Response Team (VTHMRT) was notified and provided technical assistance.
- Brattleboro One gallon of muriatic acid spilled. The VT Hazardous Material Response Team (VTHMRT) and the Agency of Natural Resources were notified
- Sharon Approximately 2-4 gallons of diesel fuel spilled. The Agency of Natural Resources was notified.
- Jericho The Jericho-Underhill Fire Department reported two separate brush fires. The Vermont Department of Forests Parks and Recreation (FPR) Wildland Fire personnel were notified.
- Vermont Fire Danger Forecast

RESOURCES DEPLOYED:

- Barnard Six members of the Vermont Forest Parks and Recreation (FPR) wildland fire personnel and four members of the U.S. Forest Service (Green Mountain National Forest) personnel with utility and fuel trucks were deployed to the wildland fire in Barnard.
- Morristown Four members of the VT Hazardous Material Response Team (VTHMRT) with 2 vehicles, an LP trailer and side-by-side trailer; and one member of the Urban Search and Rescue team were deployed to recover a 500-gallon LP tank in the river which was displaced during the July 2023 severe storms and flooding event.
